### **Summer Concert – Years 1 and 2**

Further to our recent letter, may we remind you of the key arrangements.

- The children in the Y1 and Y2 classes will be performing their Summer Concert plays at the Winston Churchill Hall in Pinn Way, Ruislip, next Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> July, at 1:30 p.m.
- There is a rehearsal next Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> June - this will not affect parents, as the Y1 and 2 children will be taken to and from the Winston Churchill Hall by coach. Packed lunches will be needed for Years 1 and 2.
- The Dress Rehearsal will be next Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> July. All children in the school (except Y6, who will be rehearsing their own play) will attend so that they can watch the Concert. **Please deliver your child to the Winston Churchill Hall next Wednesday by 8:40 a.m.** The children will return to school by coach. Please remember – packed lunches for Years 1 and 2.
- **On the day of the concert, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, school will finish at 12.00 for Years 1 and 2** and the children should be collected at this time by their parents. (All other children will have a normal school day.) The Year 1 and 2 children must arrive at the Winston Churchill Hall by 1 p.m. so that we can be ready for a 1.30 p.m. start.
- All of the Y1 and Y2 children will be taking part in the finale and will not be available for collection before the whole concert finishes.
- The concert should finish by 3 p.m. If necessary, brothers and sisters at school will be looked after by their form teachers until you arrive.
- Funtasia children can be collected from the Winston Churchill Hall by the staff, but please inform the staff in writing if you require this service.

### **Parking Issues**

Thank you for your continued cooperation over parking – the vast majority of parents continue to park considerately and many are parking away and walking the last distance to the school. The walk through the park is particularly pleasant at this time of the year.

However some problems do continue to arise;

- Please take care not to block neighbours' drives. One Long Lane resident has written to warn me that she has registered a complaint with the Council and that future transgressions could lead to tickets being issued.
- The neighbour who lives next door to Cambria (the school house in Parkway) has trouble entering and leaving his drive when cars park opposite and would be grateful if this area could be left clear.
