**Extra Curricular Activity Programme – Summer 2010**

Dear Parents,

The Extra Curricular activity programme is open to all St. Helen's pupils. You may apply for as many activities as you like, provided your child is in the year group for the activity they wish to participate in. Children who are involved in the music clubs below may be unable to participate in some activities. Occasionally individual instrumental tuition may clash with extra curricular activities. Nursery children are only able to enrol in lunchtime clubs if they are in school full time on the day the club takes place. This is because Nursery clubs do not begin until 1 hour after the morning session ends. When an after school sports activity does not start immediately after school, the children in that activity will be looked after by a form teacher in a designated classroom until the PE staff arrive.

A new activity for this term is our Film Club. In this club the children will be learning how to use the different features of a video camera, how to frame the perfect shot and how to use a storyboard to plan a film. They will then be working in groups to create their first short film! At lower school the children will now have an art club on Fridays and a craft club on Wednesdays. Due to other commitments Mrs. Mitchell-Lucker is unable to continue teaching our drama classes and also our debating club. These clubs will still run with Mrs. Hunt taking over the drama clubs at lower school. Mrs. Hunt trained with the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art. The upper drama group will be run by Ms Helen Bool-Jones, a drama and singing teacher with Stagecoach. Mrs. Smith B.A. Hons, our new PA, was a keen debater at school and is looking forward to running our debating club.

Initially, applications for all activities will be chosen at random from those received in school on the first day of term (Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> April). Those applications which are brought to the school office or handed to your child's class teacher, together with those sent in by post or put through the school letter box before the term starts, will be placed together and forms randomly picked. THIS WILL ONLY APPLY TO APPLICATIONS RECEIVED BY TUESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> APRIL AS FORMS NEED TO BE PROCESSED IMMEDIATELY.

Applications will continue to be accepted up until 10 a.m. on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> April and your child will be allocated a place in their chosen activity should any places remain. A form indicating which activities your child has been successful in applying for will be sent home by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April. If an activity is full, the form will indicate this and your child will be placed on to the appropriate waiting list for this term only.

Payment must be made at the time of booking, however, your cash/cheque will be returned to you should the activity you have chosen be full. If your cheque payment covers more than one activity, your cheque will be banked and the extra amount returned in the form of a credit voucher the following week. Credit vouchers can be used to pay for anything, except termly school fees and hot meals.

Cheques for extra curricular activities should be made payable to St. Helen's College. Please do not include payments for school fees or Funtasia with this application form. No refunds for activities will be given after Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April.
