Dear Parents,

Infant and Junior Sports Days

Enclosed with this letter you will find information about your child's Sports Day - Infant Sports Day on Friday 26th June in Court Park for Nursery to Year 2, and Junior Sports Day on Saturday 27th June at Hillingdon Athletics Stadium for Years 3 to 6.

Sports Kit We take great pride in the appearance of the children on Sports Day, and ask parents to support us by ensuring that your children have the correct kit. The following items are required:

*School sun hat

*White polo shirt with school logo

*Black school shorts, with House stripe

Plain white ankle socks - no logos

Black or white plimsolls – Nursery, Reception, Year 1

Trainers (predominantly white) – Years 2 - 6

*Culottes (optional for Y4 girls and above)

***Please note that only the styles sold by Pullens are acceptable**

Jewellery should not be worn - religious bracelets should be covered by white sweatbands. Long hair must be tied back securely.

The children should already be wearing this kit in PE lessons, and the teachers will be doing kit checks shortly in these lessons. Please ensure that the correct kit comes to school for PE lessons, and do ask if you are not sure which days they are on.

Houses There are two school Houses, Windsor (green) and Cambria (red). All children are members of a House, and the Houses compete on the Sports Days. For Nursery children, two house tapes, to be sewn on your child's shorts, are included with this letter. One tape should be sewn down each side of the shorts from the waist to the hem. Children in Reception to Year 6 who have joined the school in the last year may obtain house tapes from the school office if required (Lower School parents may order them from the school office by telephone). If you have lost your tapes from previous years, you may also get replacements from the school office. Tapes should not be sewn onto culottes.

Helpers I have invited a number of parents to help with Junior Sports Day, but there may still be vacancies. Please let me know if you will be willing to help. The duties are not onerous, and you will not miss your child's events.

We might need some volunteers to help with the Infants Sports. If you are willing to help, please let me know on the day.
