

Parking Regulations

Lower School

- Do not turn, reverse or park in the Methodist car park or forecourt.
- Do not park across the entrance to any neighbour's drive.
- Be prepared to park and walk if there are no spaces near the school.

Upper School

- Do not park outside the school or between the school and the car park, especially during the busy drop-off and collection times. Doing so causes congestion as cars attempt to move both ways along the narrow road and increases the risk that a child could be knocked down. It also creates difficulties for neighbours attempting to turn into their drives.
- Do not park across the entrance to any neighbour's drive.
- Leave the car park entrance and exit lanes clear, to allow circulation of traffic.

If the car park is full when you arrive, drive away and park elsewhere. A short walk should not be seen as a major inconvenience.

Our school is part of the community. Courtesy and neighbourliness are important. Your good example and consideration are vital if we are to avoid traffic congestion and accidents, and enjoy good relations with our neighbours,
